<https://registration.hockeycanada.ca/> There you will find a list of previous registraions, (this includes those who took CanSkate) simply look on a past receipt. (See right)

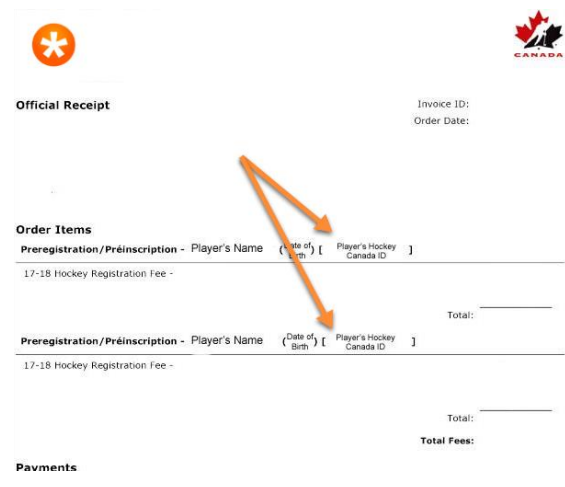
